



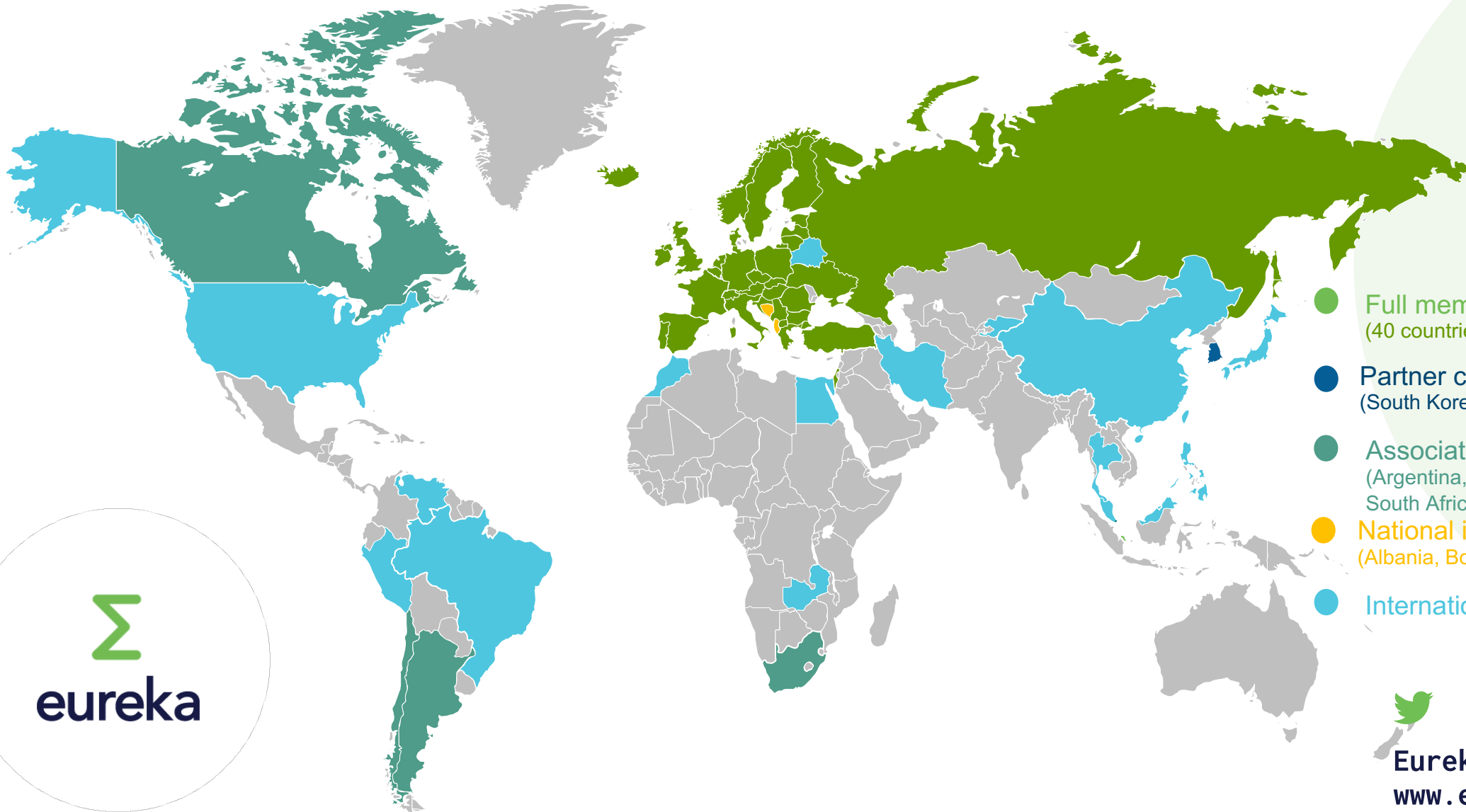

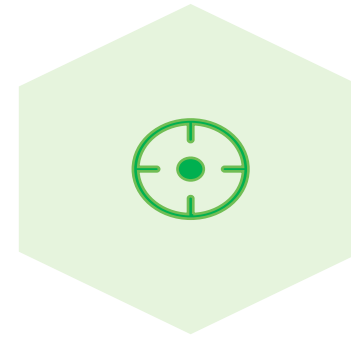

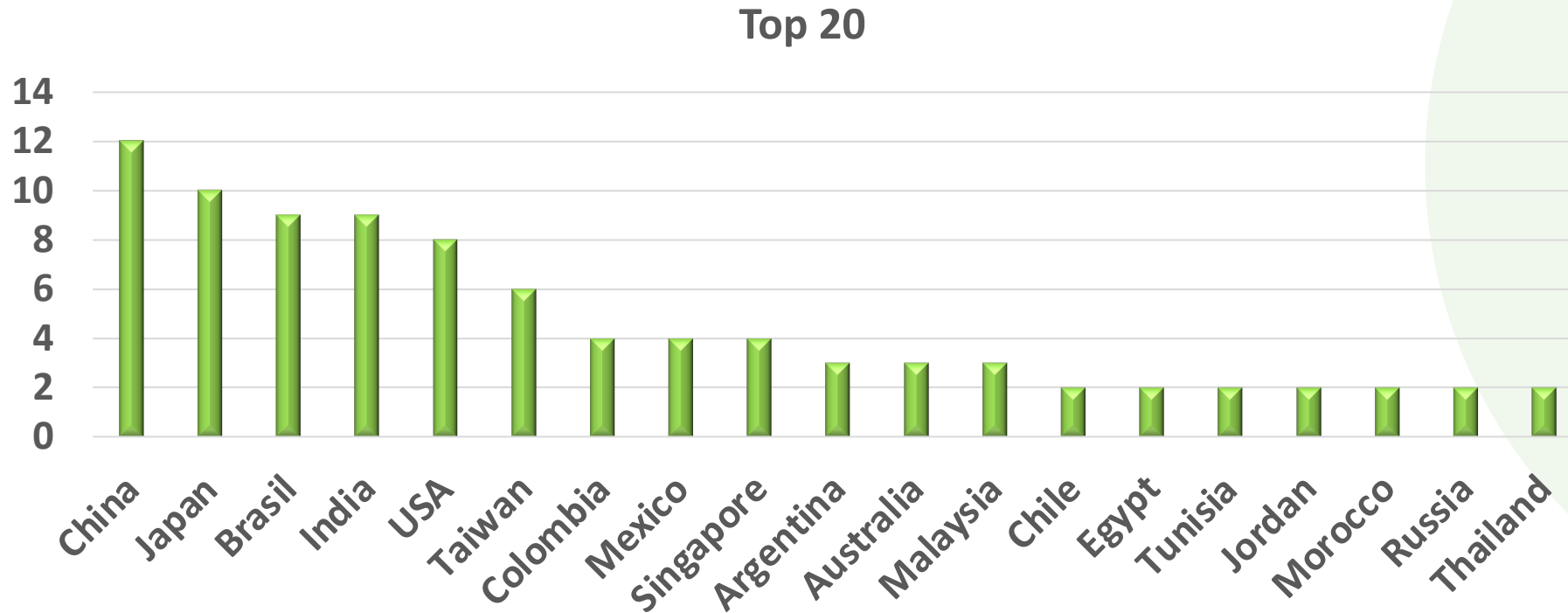

The aim of the Globalstars initiative is to facilitate international R&D&I cooperation between Eureka countries, and non-Eureka countries.

Globalstars Call - SINGAPORE (Enterprise Singapore) Deadline: 15 October 2020

- Call participation: Singapore, Austria, Belgium (Flanders), Canada, Estonia, Hungary, the Netherlands, Poland, South Africa, South Korea, Spain, Switzerland, Turkey, Ukraine and the UK.
- 87 project proposals submitted, from 15 Countries.
- Singapore leading 35 proposals followed by UK with 30, South Korea and Turkey 5 each.
- 273 participants – 12 Large enterprises; 131 SMEs; 85 Startups

- Chair: Austria + South Africa + Portugal
- Strong interest within the network (FI,DK,FR,UK,BE,ES,DE,HU,PL,NL...)
- Continuity and sustainability of actions (Multilateral call / GlobalStars call(s) in 2022)



Eureka Investment Readiness activities

- Organised as part of InvestHorizon, a 3-year accelerator programme funded by the European Commission and developed in collaboration with the Eureka network
- Companies participating in the programme benefit from several acceleration services including EUREKA's IR activities
- Access extended beyond InvestHorizon pool to Eureka companies
